The Fresno Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) is offering an excellent opportunity for an entry level or experienced planning, development, or analysis professional to serve as a LAFCo Analyst I/II/III.

Organization Overview

LAFCo is a State-mandated commission under the California Government Code with the responsibility to insure orderly growth of cities and special districts. Pursuant to State law, LAFCo reviews all proposals for changes in organization for cities and special districts in the County and conducts public hearings on these matters. The Commission is also responsible for periodically updating the spheres of influence and conducting municipal service reviews of cities and special districts in Fresno County.

Position Overview

The LAFCo Analyst series is oriented to assist the Executive Officer by performing a wide variety of research, analysis, planning, evaluation, and administrative duties. Assignments may be directed toward accomplishing either specific proposals or in support of LAFCo's work program.

The LAFCo Analyst is responsible for performing complex professional data research and analysis including analyzing complex proposals for local agency boundary changes, comprehensive studies related to the provision of local governmental services and, based on analysis, presenting summarized information and recommendations to the Executive Officer of LAFCO and the Commission.

Position Requirements

- Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's Degree that is acceptable within the United States' accredited college or university system;
- Any combination of experience and/or education acceptable to LAFCo may be substituted for the above education/experience (local land use experience highly desirable).
- Valid California Driver License is required.
