

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

FRESNO LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Fresno Local Agency Formation Commission (“LAFCo”) will consider the following at a public hearing on October 14, 2026.

1. City of Selma “Selma-North Reorganization.” A proposed reorganization of approximately 154.79 acres to the City of Selma and the Selma-Kingsburg-Fowler Sanitation District and detachment from the Fresno County Fire Protection District and the Kings River Conservation District said territory being located in two locations. The first is located generally to the north of Dinuba Avenue and Dockery Ave. The second is located north of Dinuba Avenue and west of McCall Avenue.

Regarding item 1, if you are a landowner or registered voter within the territory of “Selma-North Reorganization” as described above, you have protest rights and may file a written protest in opposition to the change of your property.

LAFCo protest forms can be found on the Fresno LAFCo website (www.fresnolafco.org) under the “Application and Documents” tab. Official LAFCo protest forms should be delivered to the Fresno LAFCo office (address below) or presented to the Commission before the end of the public hearing.

Pursuant to section 56663 of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, unless written opposition is received before the conclusion of the Commission proceedings on this proposal, the Commission intends to waive protest proceedings. There is potential for extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the local agencies.
