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**WHEREAS**, reorganization proceedings were initiated by the City of Clovis to annex 41 acres to the City of Clovis and detach from the Fresno County Fire Protection District and the Kings River Conservation District for territory located at the Southeast corner of Barstow and DeWolf Avenues, said territory being described within Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the application was submitted to this Commission by the City of Clovis as required by State Law, and the application for said proposed reorganization was accepted for filing by the Executive Officer and set for hearing on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2014, at the hour of 10:00 a.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the hearing of said application was given as required by State Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Officer reviewed said application and prepared a report to this Commission, including a recommendation for approval upon certain conditions, said report having been mailed at least five days before said hearing and was duly considered by this Commission pursuant to State Law; and

**WHEREAS**, this Commission reviewed and considered the information in the Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency, City of Clovis, which was included in the Executive Officer's report to this Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, this Commission considered all relevant factors and evidence and heard all interested parties wishing to speak on said application; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno Local Agency Formation Commission does HEREBY STATE, FIND, RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:**

**Section #1.** Acting as Responsible Agency pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, this Commission finds that prior to approving the proposed reorganization the environmental effects of the project as shown in the CEQA documents prepared, adopted, and submitted by the Lead Agency were reviewed and considered, and determined these documents to be legally adequate pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15096.

**Section #2.** This Commission finds that the proposed reorganization is sufficiently consistent with LAFCo Policies, Standards and Procedures of the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (the "Act").

**Section #3.** This Commission assigns the distinctive short form designation "Barstow-DeWolf Southeast Reorganization" and approves the reorganization (annexation and detachments) subject to the following conditions of approval:

1. The City of Clovis shall submit to the Executive Officer verification that a Right-to-Farm Covenant is required and made a part of the City's development agreement and that this legal covenant will be recorded with the final tract map approved by the City for the affected territory.
2. Ownership of land permitting, the annexation shall include the full-width right-of-way along DeWolf Avenue between Barstow Avenue and the annexation boundary, and along Barstow between DeWolf and Leonard Avenues.

**Section #4.** Pursuant to the "Act" that this Commission finds:

1. The territory is inhabited.
2. All landowners have not consented to the annexation.

**Section #5.** Pursuant to Section 56663 of the Government Code, this Commission waives further Conducting Authority Proceedings and approves the annexation and detachments subject to the requirements of the "Act," the 30-day reconsideration period, and compliance with above condition.

**Section #6.** The Commission's action approving this proposal shall expire one year from the date of this resolution unless all proceedings are complete, including condition compliance, and a Certificate of Completion issued by the Commission office.

**Section #7.** The Executive Officer is hereby authorized and directed to mail copies of this Resolution as provided in Government Code Section 56882 and to file, as appropriate, in the office of the Fresno County Clerk all environmental documents, if any, pertaining to the approval of this proposal, as required by State law.


